# Additional Information for Providers About California State-Contracted cfDNA Laboratories

### **QUEST DIAGNOSTICS LABORATORY**

#### 1. Methodology for cfDNA analysis?

The "GDSP cfDNA Panel" screening test from Quest Diagnostics uses an automated whole genome shotgun sequencing approach. A Z-score (the degree in which a data set differs from the expected outcome) is then bioinformatically generated to identify patients who are at a higher risk for a tested aneuploidy.

# 2. Can I have additional tests performed on the specimen I send for the Prenatal Screening Program screening through Quest?

At this time, Quest Diagnostics <u>does not</u> offer additional testing that can be performed on the cfDNA specimen.
